## Academy Students Make Significant Strides in Academic Tests

At the Academy, we love to watch our students' personal growth in and out of the classroom. Below are comparisons for Chi Chi's students from early fall to just before the winter break as well as midterm exams for our middle school students. Many showed significant growth in multiple subjects and the class averages shined compared to the District average (which includes all schools in the County).

## ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

ELA (English Language Arts) Fall to Winter Comparisons: 4th and 5th grade classes had the highest growth out of any 4th or 5th grade class in the County
( $22 \%$ and $25 \%$ respectively)
Math Fall to Winter Comparisons: 5th grade class had the highest growth out of any 5th grade class in the County at $16 \%$ 4th grade was the same as the District average

## MIDDLE SCHOOL

## Middle School Fall to Winter Writing Comparisons:

All 3 grades class average improved more than the District
Science Midterm Exam - Class Average:
6th Grade: $4 \%$ higher than the District
7th Grade: 7\% higher than the District
8th Grade: 3\% higher than the District
Math Midterm Exam - Class Average:
6th Grade: $1 \%$ higher than the District 7th Grade: Same as the District (.4\% higher) 8th Grade: $2 \%$ higher than the District
